New Bylaws Passed

At the Annual Meeting on May 11, 2022, the Board discussed the need for new Bylaws and requested the community's assistance by reviewing the new draft of the Bylaws and providing feedback. The new Bylaws were improved with the help of approximately two dozen members of the subdivision. The process went through several drafts and meetings with subdivision members. The final draft was reviewed by attorney Richard D. Linnell of Linnell & Associates, PLLC, and all proposed changes were accepted. Copies of the new bylaws were mailed to all the homes in the subdivision and voting was opened. Voting was completed at an HOA meeting held on November 20, 2023. The bylaws in effect at the time required changes to be approved by two-thirds of the votes cast. The votes were 120 for and 3 against, so the vote passed.
