Crime Prevention

- Park in a well lit area and if possible park in the garage
- Make sure your garage door is closed and side doors locked

Roads & Safety

Power Forum

The Kimberley Association board is planning a future education forum to discuss backup / standby power generation. The forum is intended to provide an update on power reliability in the sub and mainly focus on backup options such as portable and standby whole house generators. Topics will include types of generators, how they work, sizing, safety, installation/maintenance, and cost/benefit. A licensed electrician and at least one generator supplier will be on hand to conduct the discussion. This event has been designed for educational purposes and will include lots of Q&A.
